Smallfield Lane road closure, 8-15 September

There is scheduled disruption to vehicle access along Smallfield Lane between Tuesday (8 September) and the following Tuesday (15 September), for fitting water and power connections to the new vicarage. Trenches will need to be dug and subsequently filled and re-asphalted. There will be a 'road closed' traffic setup during these works. Residents will still be able to access their properties but will have to wait a few minutes for a road plate to be put over the trench to allow their vehicles across. The excavations will be road plated overnight to allow normal access for residents. If you have any questions, contact Shaun.

Prayer for Te Awa Kairangi/Hutt River, 20 September

An event in the annual Season of Creation (1 September to 4 October) is prayer for Te Awa Kairangi/Hutt River, Sunday 20 September. This ecumenical event will start with Mass at Harcourt Park 8.00. There will then be five prayer stations: Moonshine Park 10.30 to 10.45am; Whakawhirinaki - Silverstream Pipe Bridge 12.00 to 12.15pm; Avalon Park 3.00 to 3.15pm; a shelter near Ewen Bridge 4.15 to 4.30pm; and at the Pito-one foreshore 5.45 to 6.15pm.

You are invited to gather at any station to pray, or to walk sections of the river
