There is **one motion** to date:

That the St John's Trentham parish approves the building of a new vicarage on our church land:

- using the EasyBuild Glenochy design option plus a double garage funded by the Vicarage Fund
- (currently \$427,000) plus a mortgage of no more than \$260,000
- with building commencing in 2025
- subject to satisfactory site engineering tests (estimated to cost up to \$6,500).

This will be followed by a shared lunch so please bring a plate.
